

Memo 2 Week of Oct 13 Barbados trip

Mon. Oct 13

Talked to Kandi last night on Windows live messenger voice and video call. I get an echo on my end. I will try Skype sometime this week.

To day has been another rainy day. I was up at 6 and did my devotions and some work on a sermon, using Jeremiah.

Michael and I took a bus to Bridgetown around 11:00 AM and cruised Bridgetown until around 3:30 PM, hopped on an other bus and came back to Kenroy's. Oh yes it was raining when we got off the bus and walked 15 minutes to the house in the rain.

Tue Oct 14

Dale was suppose to pick us up this afternoon but it was raining so hard and the road were flooded that we put is off till Thursday. Kenroy told me that I was preaching for him this Sunday. So I spent some time getting some ideas and started to prepare.

Wed Oct 15

There we 18 at the service. Michael lead the service, and then we had prayer for the 15-19 that are going to Antigua to help a new growing church. Service was over around 9:15 and we made it home around 10:30, after we stopped at Cheveittes and got some thing to eat.

Dale came to pick us up around 2 and took us around to Grazettes.

Took Kenroy and Stephaine and went out and had ribs, chicken, and fish at Eddy's favorite stand.
